

### Checklist for the Prescription of MEFLOQUINE Chemoprophylaxis:

The following checklist provides a brief guide to conditions that are contraindications to MEFLOQUINE chemoprophylaxis. The checklist is designed to assist in determining the patient's eligibility for MEFLOQUINE chemoprophylaxis. All items should be checked in the presence of the patient or his/her caregiver. If **one** of the checklist questions 1-4 is answered with "**Yes**" then the patient is **ineligible** for MEFLOQUINE chemoprophylaxis.
